PARENTAL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

I/WE, _____, the parent/guardian(s) of _____, who plays for the North Davidson Soccer League, agree to the following code of conduct.

- I will respect the opposing team and its players and will not engage in any
- Disrespectful conduct.
- I will respect referees and will not challenge or show dissent with their officiating.
- I will respect my team's coach and abide by his/her direction and leadership.

If I violate any of the above provisions, I will adhere to the following discipline:

- ◆ Disrespect to an opposing player – 1 game suspension
- ◆ Ejection from a game (first offense*) – 1 game suspension
- ◆ Ejection from a game (second offense*) – 1 season suspension
- ◆ Ejection from a game (third offense*) – Life time suspension from participation in TCL
- ◆ Verbal assault/hostile challenge of a referee/coach/player – 1 year suspension from attending games.
- ◆ Physical assault of referee/coach/player – Life time suspension from participation in TCL

This code of conduct does not exclude discipline by the local association/club or NCYSA.

In the case of an ejection, the parent must leave the park/facility (out of sight and sound) in which the field is located and can not return until 1 hour after their teams next match. If the parent does return before this time, an additional 2 game suspension will be incurred.

Parent Code of Conduct

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for **all** players, coaches and game officials.
- I will place the physical and emotional well being of my child **and** the other children ahead of any personal desire to win.
- If I feel that my child is not playing in a safe and positive environment, I will address my concerns with: 1) the coach, 2) the sport's Director, 3) the Director of Coaches or Board Member. This includes but is not limited to concerns of: facility/equipment safety, actions of coaches, actions of players, actions of referees, actions of other parents.
- I will provide only positive support for the coaches working with my child to ensure a positive, enjoyable and fun experience.
- I will always remember the game is for the kids and not the adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will support the team rules and regulations that will be set forth by the team at the beginning of the season. This includes committing to have my child at practice and games on time. If my child is unable to attend, I will make every attempt to notify the coach prior to missing.
- I understand that an official generally makes the correct call even when I see the incident differently. If an error is made, I will remember that: 1) no one is perfect, 2) the number of incorrect calls usually balances out for both teams, 3) the officials have a different viewpoint than mine, 4) the occasional incorrect call seldom affects the outcome of the game and 5) there are lessons to be learned from these occurrences that are often more important than winning/losing.
- Any and all comments that come out of my mouth to the coaches, referees, players or other parents will be positive ones only. I will notify the Coach, Sport's Director, Coach's Director or Board Member of any situation that I feel are negative for the program and allow them to address the situation.
- I will familiarize myself with the rules of the sport so that I might help my child learn and that I might better appreciate and enjoy the game.
- I will not embarrass my child, team, or coaches by yelling in a negative manner at other players, coaches, parents or referees.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- I will require that my child's coach adhere to the Coaches' Code of Ethics. I agree with these rules and understand that NDSL has adopted a Zero-Tolerance Policy and that not abiding by these basic rules may restrict me from attending future games and practices.

North Davidson Soccer League Player Code of Conduct

- Players will refrain from using profanity during any sporting event.
- Players will refrain from using disparaging dialogue with referees, teammates, coaches, opponents or spectators.
- Players will not, under any circumstances, participate in physical violence or threats thereof at any sporting event.
- Evidence of use of alcohol, illegal drugs, or tobacco products before or during practices or games will result in immediate suspension from team for two games upon the first offense and for the remainder of the season upon the second offense.
- Property damage will result in suspension from the team and full restitution to the property owner by the player and/or parents.
- Players will obey the laws of the game.
- Players will make every attempt to notify the coach prior to missing a practice in order to receive an excused absence.
- Players will make every attempt to arrive at practice and games on time and will have all necessary equipment prepared. This includes bringing your own water.
- Players understand that NDSL has adopted a Zero-Tolerance Policy in regards to unsportsmanlike conduct. Violation could result in immediate suspension or expulsion from sporting events organized by NDSL.
